SCHOLARSHIP AND BURSARIES

Heathfield Knoll School grants a number of scholarships each year, which recognise outstanding academic achievements, artistic ability, music and performing arts talents and sporting potential. These select number of pupils will receive enhanced access and provision to our curriculum.

Pupils who are awarded a scholarship at HKS will also receive up to 50% remission of school fees and in addition may also be eligible for gratis additional tuition in their chosen subject(s).

As well as offering an exceptional scholarship programme at Heathfield Knoll School, we also offer a number of bursaries to enable children to benefit from a high-quality education, with extra curriculum activities, despite your financial circumstances.

# SCHOLARSHIPS

Heathfield Knoll scholarships are awarded to pupils to inspire and instil excellence in a range of academic and co-curricular activities which follow the ethos of the school's values.

- Scholarships are awarded to those pupils in Year 6 and Year 9. In exceptional circumstances, scholarships are awarded to those pupils who are showing talent from Year 5.
- Scholarships are awarded to internal and external pupils.



# SCHOLARSHIPS



- All scholarships can also accompany any bursarial support with up to 100% remission of fees.
- Pupils awarded scholarships will remain scholars throughout their time at Heathfield Knoll School. Please see the scholarship policy [here](#) for more details.
- Scholars will be champions of the School showing exceptional leadership skills. There will be an expectation that school rehearsal, fixtures and events will be prioritised over any other external event.

# BURSARIES

Families who are looking for support in relation to school fees at Heathfield Knoll School can apply for a bursary. Bursaries are means-tested which means the amount of funding is calculated based upon parent(s) personal financial circumstances. Bursaries can offer up to a 100% remission of fees depending on circumstances and can also be offered alongside a scholarship.

- Bursaries are available to children of all abilities from Reception to Year 11.
- Depending on circumstances a bursary can also be offered alongside a scholarship for additional support with school fees.
